### Phase One

**SPECIFIC TYPES OF EMPLOYERS** 

SCHOOLS AND ORGANIZED YOUTH ACTIVITIES (e.g., daycare, camp) that are

VISITS TO SENIOR LIVING FACILITIES AND HOSPITALS should be prohibited. Those who do interact with residents and patients must adhere to strict protocols LARGE VENUES (e.g., sit-down dining, movie theaters, sporting venues, places of

orship) can operate under strict physical distancing protocol **ELECTIVE SURGERIES** can resume, as clinically appropriate, on an outpatient basis at facilities that adhere to CMS guidelines.

**GYMS** can open if they adhere to strict physical distancing and sanitation protocols

BARS should remain closed.

## SCHOOLS AND ORGANIZED YOUTH ACTIVITIES (e.g., daycare, camp) can reope

VISITS TO SENIOR CARE FACILITIES AND HOSPITALS should be prohibited. Those who do interact with residents and patients must adhere to strict protocols

LARGE VENUES (e.g., sit-down dining, movie theaters, sporting venues, places of ip) can operate under moderate physical distancing protocols

**ELECTIVE SURGERIES** can resume, as clinically appropriate, on an outpatient and in-patient basis at facilities that adhere to CMS guidelines. GYMS can remain open if they adhere to strict physical distancing and sanitation

BARS may operate with diminished standing-room occupancy, where applicable


