- ❖ State parks, fishing, hunting and golf courses, Retail curbside only, restaurant dining in specific counties, pet grooming

### West Virginia:

- ❖ Restaurants for outdoor dining
- ❖ Salons, Barbershops and pet groomers
- ❖ Gyms and recreation centers
- ❖ *Reopening Soon: Restaurants/ dining and bars, retail stores and malls, state parks and campgrounds, museums and zoos, tanning salons*

### Wisconsin:
